That speech won him the prestigious title of World Champion of Public Speaking.

However, even as a world champion of public speaking, Aaron is one of the most introverted people you can meet. Like many others, Aaron believed that public speaking and storytelling were "extroverted" activities meant for the boldest and loudest people in the room. But, with hard work, dedication and a team of invaluable supporters, Aaron has become proficient in both skills and has since learned that introversion is an asset when it comes to communication.

Aaron has been invited to speak at Fortune 100 companies and notable Universities And has engaged audiences in various countries around the world. He doesn't credit his achievements to an advanced degree, or a privileged life. He credits it to learning effective communication and public speaking.


