### July

- Review last year's <u>Distinguished Club Program</u> (DCP) results for your club.
- Establish the club's goals for the current year's Distinguished Club Program.
- Read the relevant sections in the Club Leadership Handbook.
- Review the Product Guide and order educational materials.

#### **August**

- Attend District-sponsored <u>Club Officer Training</u> if you did not attend in June or July.
- Conduct executive committee meeting with each officer reporting on activities/accomplishments/plans.
- Review the club's goals for the current year <u>Distinguished Club Program</u>.

#### September

- Conduct executive committee meeting with each officer reporting on activities/accomplishments/plans.
- Review the club's goals for the current year Distinguished Club Program.

#### **October**

- Conduct executive committee meeting with each officer reporting on activities/accomplishments/plans.
- Review the club's goals for the current year <u>Distinguished Club Program</u>.

#### **November**

- If your club elects officers semiannually, conduct club officer elections.
- Conduct executive committee meeting with each officer reporting on activities/accomplishments/plans.
- Review the club's goals for the current year <u>Distinguished Club Program</u>.

#### **December**

 Attend district-sponsored <u>Club Officer Training</u>. Note that officers must attend both training cycles for DCP credit whether the club elects annually or semiannually or had also attended training in the June-August period.

- Conduct the Speech Contests to qualify members for the Area Contest.
- Review the club's goals for the current year Distinguished Club Program.

#### March

- Promote <u>Area Speech Contests</u> and encourage all members to attend in support of club's contestants.
- Conduct executive committee meeting with each officer reporting on activities/accomplishments/plans.
- Review the club's goals for the current year Distinguished Club Program...

#### **April**

- Promote <u>Division Speech Contests</u> and encourage all members to attend in support of Area's contestants.
